
In 1981, the Calgary Research & Development Authority was established. The organization was later renamed to Calgary Technologies Inc. (CTI) and it operated the Alaistair Ross Technology Centre on the University of Calgary Research Park.



The inspiration for Platform was born out of Rainforest Calgary, to bring about connection and focus in the Calgary tech community, and CTI was rebranded to Platform in March 2019.



On June 6, 2022, Platform Calgary moved from the Alaistair Ross Technology Centre to the Platform Innovation Centre in downtown Calgary.




Rainforest Calgary was started in 2015 as a grassroots initiative to foster innovation and build a thriving tech ecosystem in Alberta. Working with community partners, Platform established the citywide goal in 2021 to create 30,000 new tech jobs in Calgary at 3,000 companies. Over 140,000 people went through Platform Calgary's doors in 2024.






## **Single Point of Access**


## 1,169 LOCAL COMPANIES LEADING THE WAY




